- incorporated into the integrated assessment framework of this project
- decision makers from EU, national, and regional level can draw on when looking for adaptation options
- contribute to the adaptation knowledge base.





What is the inventory?


- Lists of 104 measures
- Found in NAS, RAS, projects, literature, case studies
- Focus on water management addressing: *Flooding, WS&D, Water quality*
- 9 categories including *Technical*, *Awareness*, *Regulatory*, *Economic*, *Land use* & *planning*...
- Covers water dependent sectors (agriculture, energy, industry, tourism...)



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- Currently in Excel format
- Measures are described by 3 sets of attributes
 - 1. Descriptive attributes
 - 2. Assessment criteria
 - 3. Additional information (link to EU-level)

- side-effects
- Performance under uncertainty
- Conditions for decision making
