INTERNATIONAL CORAL REEF INITIATIVE

- ICRI is a global partnership between Nations and organisations that strives to preserve coral reefs and related ecosystems around the world
- Founded in 1994 by 8 nations, at the inaugural CBD COP: Australia, France, Japan, Jamaica, the Philippines, Sweden, United Kingdom, and the United States of America
- ICRI now counts 102 members, including 45 countries accounting for over 75% of the world's coral reefs
- ICRI is currently chaired by the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia represented by The General Organisation for the Conservation of Coral Reefs and Sea Turtles in the Red Sea (SHAMS)
- The Plan of Action 2025 2027 is currently under development
- The GCRMN, established in 1995, is an operational network of ICRI


